Requirements

To be eligible to participate in the Little Miss & Mr. Great Pocomoke Fair contest, participants must be at least 5 years old but not older than 7 years of age on the day of the contest, and they must reside in either Worcester, Somerset, Wicomico or Accomack County.

Contest participants will be asked to sing a child's song or recite a child's poem or nursery rhyme as their talent for the contest. No props, stuffed animals, flags, musical instruments, recorded music, etc. shall be used during the contest. Participants will be interviewed briefly by the contest MC on stage prior to performing their talent.

The newly crowned Little Miss & Mr. Great Pocomoke Fair must be available to ride in the Pocomoke Christmas Parade held the first Monday evening after Thanksgiving and will be asked to crown the Little Miss & Mr. Great Pocomoke Fair at next year's competition. Additionally, the Little Miss & Mr. Great Pocomoke Fair may also be asked to participate in other fairground sponsored events throughout the year.

In the event that the Little Miss or Mr. contest winners are unable to fulfill his or her duties, the runner-up(s) will fill in for him or her. In order to do this, the reigning Little Miss or Mr. will be asked to temporarily relinquish their crown(s), robe(s), and sash(es) for the event. All items will be returned to the reigning Little Miss or Mr. after the event's conclusion.

Registration for the contest must be completed on the form below and received at least 5 days prior to the event date. The Little Miss & Mr. Great Pocomoke Fair contest is held the first night of the fair at 6PM. This year's event will be held on August 4, 2011. Registration forms must be received on or before July 30, 2011 for eligibility in the contest.

Guidelines for the Contest

All participants are asked to be at the Grand Stand no later than 5:30pm on the night of the event. Please check in your child at the registration desk inside the main building so that we know you have arrived. The contest will begin promptly at 6PM.

The appropriate dress for Little Miss participants is a dress (sundress, church dress, fancy pageant dress, etc). The appropriate dress for Little Mr. participants is a pair of dress slacks and a button up dress shirt. Points will not be deducted however for other types of clothing.

Prizes, Trophies, & Awards

All participants in the contest will receive a trophy and a "goody" bag filled with toys, restaurant certificates, books, candy, etc. Additionally, the chosen Little Miss & Mr. Great Pocomoke Fair will also receive a crown, hooded robe, embroidered sash, a free sitting and 8x10 portrait package, a \$50 savings bond, and free amusement rides during each evening of the fair.

Return of the Hooded Robe

The hooded robe must be dry cleaned and returned to the contest organizer, Lisa Taylor (410.957.3414), at least 5 days prior to the next year's event. All other prizes and awards are the property of the participants and winners.
